Day 01 LONDON HEATHROW - JOHANNESBURG

Depart London Heathrow to Pemba in Mozambique via Johannesburg with South African Airways.



Continue to Pemba via Johannesburg with South African Airways.

You will be met on arrival in Pemba and taken for your short light aircraft flight to Ibo Island.



CRAVI Economy Dep: Pemba 15:00 Arr: Ibo 15:30


You have arrived ! You will be met at the airstrip and driven to the Ibo Island Lodge by the only car on the whole island. The drive takes 20 minutes and you will start to see why this island is so special as you pass the crumbling colonial buildings and forts. You can check in on arrival and relax after your journey.

Ibo Island Lodge



1 x Standard Room on a Full Board basis for 4-nights

Ibo Island Lodge is located on the prime waterfront site on Ibo Island in the Quirimba's Archipelago. Three historic and magnificent mansions, each over one hundred and fifty years old, have been lovingly restored to their former glory and make up this Mozambique Hotel. The 14 luxurious rooms come equipped with air-conditioning and ceiling fans to keep things cool in the balmy tropical weather and are individually designed and feature elegant pillars, meter thick coral and lime walls, lofty tall ceilings and solid teak beams. This is a great example of some of the best and most unique Mozambique Accommodation. The lodge is set amongst lush gardens planted with frangipani, bougainvillea and palm trees with a delightful swimming pool overlooking the bay. The heart of Ibo Island Lodge is upstairs on the Bela Vista roof deck restaurant where you will sip sundowners and after dinner drinks under spectacular stars. The roof top terrace faces west for unbelievable sunsets.





Days 03 - 05 IBO ISLAND

Days at leisure to enjoy activities from Ibo Island Lodge. Guest experiences at Ibo Island Lodge are some of the most varied in all of Africa. The island is steeped in ancient architecture, history and culture, and the numerous guided tours bring the fascinating legends alive. There is also outstanding scuba diving and snorkelling, castaway beach picnics, guided sea kayaking, birding safaris, traditional dhow sailing, the mangrove forest experience, massage and a daily traditional dhow boat journey to an idyllic low tide sandbank.



Imagine a remote Mozambican island lost in time and almost forgotten to the outside world for nearly a century. Picture grand, majestic architecture, some lovingly restored to their former glory while others have fallen into crumbling, marvellous ruins. Combine that with fascinating history, culture, an idyllic white sandbank beach and some of Africa's richest coral reefs – You have Ibo, the amazing Ibo Island.



Snack on cashew nuts and tropical fruit and feast on seafood of every description. Ibo Island has been described as one of the most magical, atmospheric and unique places in Africa. The island is also one of the oldest and most romantic settlements in Africa and is nominated for World Heritage Status. The mystery, the magic, the culture and the beauty of Ibo Island beckons.



Day 06 IBO ISLAND - GULUDO BEACH LODGE

Time to leave Ibo Island behind you today and head to Guludo beach lodge on the Mozambique mainland. You will be picked up from the port, just around the corner from Ibo and taken to Guludo by boat, which takes around 1 hour.



The time of pickup depends on the tides but Ibo Island Lodge and Guludo will liaise a couple of days before hand so you will be aware. You will arrive at Guludo and can settle in and relax with a perfect beach a few steps from your private Banda.

Guludo Beach Lodge



1 x Banda on a Full Board basis for 6-nights

Guludo is a small lodge located on mainland Mozambique within the beautiful Quirmbas National Park and on a 12km stretch of perfect white sand. The main lounge and dining Banda sits above the beach, with views over the sea – sunsets are breath-taking. Its construction is simple, with open sides, stone floors, high thatch roofs and locally made furniture. The 7 Banda's are beautifully simple and provide everything you need and nothing you don't. The bedroom is a large space with a high roof, king-size bed with mosquito netting with shutters that afford beach views right from your bed. Behind the bedroom is a large open air bathroom with twin sinks and mirrors, ingeniously carved out of the Banda wall. A huge and ingenious gravity shower completes a Zen like space from where you can shower under the canopy of bright stars. Positioned to the side of the private bathroom and up a small staircase is one the best views in the lodge... the view from the eco-loo! Each Banda is located just a few steps from the beach and your swimming pool is the beautiful waters of the warm Indian Ocean. Guludo is not for everyone and there are a few points to note, for example, although charging things like cameras and mobile phones are possible at the main lodge the rooms do not have electricity, nor do they have running water. The toilettes are dry compositing, clean and odourless and the lodge does not offer guests an internet connection - luxury here is in the form of the culture, activities, views and experience.





Days 07 - 11 GULUDO

Day at leisure to enjoy activities from Guludo or simply relax and enjoy the stunning coastline.



Some of the activities that are included within the cost of your stay include visiting the Guludo village, sunset sail, beauty on the beach, beach archery, village football, pottery and dhow boat Fishing.

There are also many activities available at additional cost such as, visiting Rolas Island, driving to the Quirimbas national park bush lookout, Whale watching, snorkelling scuba diving in some of the best dives sites in the Indian Ocean.


Enjoy the sunsets in this magical part of Africa.





Day 12 GULUDO BEACH LODGE – PEMBA – JOHANNESBURG – UK

You will leave Guludo today and head back to the airport for your flights to the UK via Johannesburg. You will drive from Guludo to Pemba which is a fascinating and fantastic drive, the journey takes you through the stunning Quirimbas National Park and some local villages and will give you a great glimpse of life in Northern Mozambique. The journey takes approximately three and a half to four hours and is 250km long; 200km on an excellent tar road and 50km is on a good dirt road. You will be able to check in on arrival for your flights to the UK via Johannesburg with South African Airways.



Arrive back into London Heathrow or other regional airport.
