Day 02 CAPE TOWN

Arrive into Cape Town International Airport. Clear customs and immigration formalities.

On arrival, you will be met by our local representative who will assist you in meeting a private transfer to your hotel (around 25-mins). You will also receive a detailed Travel Digest with detailed driving instructions and lots of other useful local information.

Four Rosmead 1 x Luxury Room on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 3-nights


Early Check-in: Early check-in on arrival requested but not guaranteed.

Situated on the slopes of Table Mountain, Four Rosmead is within walking distance of Green Market Square and is 10 minutes by car from the V&A Waterfront, Kirstenbosch Gardens, Clifton and Camps Bay beaches. Originally built in 1903, the guest house is a listed monument and impresses with its landscaped garden and chic interior. This stylish property offers 10 rooms and facilities include a dining room, landscaped gardens and a heated swimming pool with sun loungers.

Luxury Rooms are situated on the ground floor with easy access to the gardens. Two of the three luxury rooms have a private outside area and can be accessed directly from the secure off-street parking.







On the morning of Day 03 your hire car will be delivered to your hotel.

Days at leisure to explore Cape Town and the Cape Peninsula.



Cape Town is South Africa's oldest city and is stunningly situated between Table Mountain and the clear waters of the Atlantic. The 'Mother City' is truly one of the world's most beautiful cities and is packed with immense charm and historical interest. Take a cable car up Table Mountain, a boat to Robben Island or simply enjoy a leisurely stroll through Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. Indulge yourself at the vineyards of elegant Constantia, see the brightly painted houses of Bo-Kaap, experience colourful townships or simply relax on a nearby beach. Cape Town is a diverse and iconic city that offers something for everyone and warrants an extended stay. As well as its many sites, the shopping and dining options are equally appealing. The modern Victoria and Alfred Waterfront development has numerous specialist stores, craft markets and eateries with stunning views of the mountain and its characteristic 'tablecloth' of cloud.

A drive of the Cape Peninsula is a must. The drive to the Cape Peninsula National Park and the Cape of Good Hope takes you along Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the most breath-taking coastal journeys you can take. Among the numerous highlights of this peninsula are the picturesque harbour of Hout Bay, the African Penguin colony at Boulders Beach and the long sandy beach of Muizenberg.



Day 05 CAPE TOWN - FRANSCHHOEK

Drive to Franschhoek and your hotel.

Cape Town to Franschhoek: This drive is around 80km and should take around 1.5 hours.

Day 06 FRANSCHHOEK

Days at leisure to explore Franschhoek and the Cape Winelands.



Situated in the heart of the Cape Winelands, surrounded by serenely beautiful homesteads and vineyards and dramatically situated in a valley overlooked by the mighty mountains of the Franschhoek-berg the quiet little town of Franschhoek was established by the Huguenots who settled here in 1688 after leaving France to escape persecution. The French tradition of fine cuisine has grown from these humble origins with Franschhoek now boasting many fine restaurants as well as local art and craft galleries.



Day 07 FRANSCHHOEK - OUDTSHOORN

Drive to Oudtshoorn and your hotel.

Franschhoek to Oudtshoorn: This drive is around 380km and should take around 4.5 hours.

With private entrances, sunny verandas and elegant, comfortable antiques, each of the 20 individually furnished air-conditioned units offer satellite television, free Wi-Fi, mini bar and abundant comforts.


With their private entrances and sunny verandas, the Luxury Rooms are individually furnished room is decorated with the richest fabrics to enhance the various woods used in the antiques. Crisp white linen on thick, comfortable mattresses make for a relaxing night's sleep. The birds in the garden will be the first thing you hear in the morning before stepping out of bed onto personalized Persian rugs: rejuvenated and ready for the sights and sounds the Oudtshoorn area has to offer. Day 08 OUDTSHOORN

Days at leisure to explore Oudtshoorn and the Klein Karoo.



Surrounded by natural beauty in the heart of the semi-arid Klein Karoo, Oudtshoorn is situated at the foot of the majestic Swartberg Mountain range, 55km from the large coastal town of George. Known as the ostrich capital of Africa a visit to one of the many ostrich farms is a must while in the region, while other attractions include the Swartberg Pass (one of South Africa's most spectacular mountain passes) and the Cango Caves. Numerous rivers, streams and falls have their origins in the surrounding mountains giving rise to some picturesque waterfalls, visit a cheetah breeding project, walk with wild meerkats or simply wonder around town admiring the beautiful old sandstone 'feather palaces' that hint at the town's prosperous past.

Day 09 OUDTSHOORN – PLETTENBERG BAY

Drive just beyond Plettenberg Bay and your hotel.

Oudtshoorn to The Crags: This drive is around 190km and should take around 3 hours.

Hog Hollow Country Lodge 1 x Standard Suite on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 2-nights

Located just 18km east of Plettenberg Bay and set on the edge of indigenous forest with breath-taking views of the surrounding valleys and Tsitsikamma Mountains, this lodge offers 16 unique African-styled rooms with private decks. There is also a villa 400 metres from the main lodge overlooking the forests and mountains and is ideal for families. Other facilities include an honesty bar, complimentary Wi-Fi and a stunning outdoor swimming pool.

The 16 Standard Suites are all situated in the gardens surrounding the main house. Decorated in earthy colours, with hand crafted artefacts scattered throughout, all feature king size beds (or twin if you prefer) and a well-stocked mini-bar. Sit out on your private wooden deck listening to the sounds of a garden humming with life, enveloped in the warmth of the African sun.





Day 10 PLETTENBERG BAY

Days at leisure to explore the Plettenberg Bay area and the scenic 'Garden Route'.



'Plett', the holiday town of South Africa's rich and famous, is situated on the warm Indian Ocean offering sandy beaches, challenging golf courses and a vibrant nightlife. Enjoy dolphin spotting boat cruises, visit the Monkeyland Primate Sanctuary where visitors can expect to see many species of monkeys as well as a large variety of forest dwelling birds, and explore the Tsitsikamma National Park a rugged coastal nature reserve offering beautiful coastal scenery and a variety of walks and hikes. Close by are all the attractions of the 'Garden Route'.



Day 11 PLETTENBERG BAY – AMAKHALA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Drive to the Eastern Cape and to Amakhala Private Game Reserve and your safari lodge.

The Crags to Amakhala Private Game Reserve: This drive is around 285km and should take around 3 hours.

Fully-Inclusive Basis: Your stay includes all meals, selected local beer, wine and soft drinks, two game activities daily and conversation levy.

Bush Lodge which is positioned at the top end of an open valley in the Amakhala Game Reserve offers ensuite, tented and thatched suites overlooking a wild life watering point with big sky views. The main lodge offers luxurious dining, splendid lounge areas and an expansive viewing deck with magnificent views of gamefilled plains. Evenings are spent around the outdoor fireplace admiring the unspoilt African star-scape. The guest reception is at the colonial Reed Valley Inn, from where guests are transferred into the reserve to enjoy the comfort and elegance of the tented accommodation. Bush Lodge offers twice-daily expeditions by open 4x4 safari vehicles.

Each of the five Luxury Tents have an open deck with plunge pool, air conditioning (hot & cold), fire place, large oval bath and outdoor shower.





Days 12 - 13 AMAKHALA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Shared guided activities from your safari lodge.



Amakhala Game Reserve is located in the malaria-free Eastern Cape. Day and night game viewing trips under guidance of professional game rangers are available. Wildlife likely to be encountered during the game drives in the Game Reserve are the 'Big Five' including lion, elephant, rhino, buffalo and leopard as well as cheetah, giraffe, zebra, wildebeest and plenty of antelope species. Visits to nearby Game Parks such as the Addo Elephant National Park and Shamwari Game Reserve can be arranged at request.

Day 14 AMAKHALA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE – PORT ELIZABETH - JOHANNESBURG

Arr: Johannesburg 15:05

Arr: London Heathrow 05:00 (+1 day)

Morning game drive and breakfast at your lodge.

Afterwards, drive to Port Elizabeth Airport and drop-off your hire car.

Amakhala Private Game Reserve to Port Elizabeth: This drive is around 80km and should take around 1.5 hours.

Check-in for your return flights with South African Airways and then British Airways via Johannesburg.

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Day 15 LONDON

Arrive back into London Heathrow.
