

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Day 02 JOHANNESBURG – LUSAKA – MFUWE – SOUTH LUANGWA

Arrive into Johannesburg International Airport and meet an onward flight with South African Airways.

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Arrive into Lusaka International Airport. Clear customs and immigration formalities.

Visas:

British passport holders need a visa to enter Zambia. You can get a visa from the Zambian High Commission in London before you travel. Single and double entry visit visas are available on arrival at all ports of entry, but multi-entry visas are not. If you plan to get a visa on arrival, make sure you have the correct amount of cash (US dollars) with you as change may not be available. If you enter through Kenneth Kaunda International Airport you can now make payment for single and double entry visas via credit or debit card at the Zambian Immigration desks.

KAZA Univisa:

The KAZA visa is valid for travel between Zambia and Zimbabwe and day trips into Botswana. It's available at the international airports in Lusaka and Livingstone and at the land borders at Livingstone (Zimbabwe border) and Kazungula (Botswana border). It costs US\$50 and it is valid for 30 days.

Passport Validity:

Your passport should be valid for a minimum period of 6 months from the date of entry into Zambia and have 2 blank pages.

On arrival you will be met by our local representative who will assist you in meeting an onward flight with Proflight Zambia.

Lion Camp



The luxury tents have been spread out to create more privacy, and there are two new deluxe tents to maximise prime locations. The camp has strong sustainable principles at its core, ensuring minimal impact on the environment with maximum longevity.






With incredible game viewing literally on our doorstep, all the Luxury Tents have been designed to maximise the views. The eight tents have canvas walls and a thatch roof. During the day, the netting at the front of the tent can be tied back to access a shaded private deck directly from the bedroom. Bathrooms are off to the side to provide more privacy, whilst ensuring an unobstructed view out. Evening breeze cooling units have been installed for maximum comfort in the hotter months. These units along with the rest of the camp are solar-powered.

All safari activities are led by qualified guides who will educate and enlighten you in the secrets of the park. Game drives are conducted in open Land Rovers. Walking safaris are accompanied by an experienced and armed escort scout.

Walking safaris are a very different option. They bring you in touch with the wilderness and tend to focus more on the minutiae of the park and the eco-system. It is a truly unforgettable experience striding out in country where you are on the same footing as a lion or elephant.

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Days 06 - 07 KAFUE

Shared guided activities from your safari lodge.




Alongside the three game viewers the lodge is the proud owners of Zambia's very first 'Electronic Landrover' (eLandy). This vehicle allows you to experience all the sights and sounds of the bush in near silence and with a sense of environmental care. The eLandy is kept close to camp and operates in the Game Management Area for short drives or the relatively common 'dinner table dash' to investigate what that sound in the night was or how close those lion calls are!

The eLandy aside, the three top of the range game viewers reside on the park side of the river. It's a quick float in a boat over to them which is always a nice way to start the morning! The guides are all masters of their craft, spend a morning or afternoon exploring the park with them and see what you can find. Regular sightings include lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, a wide range of antelopes including roan, sable and zebra, hippo, crocodile, warthog, genet, jackal, mongoose, every entertaining baboons and monkeys and a myriad of species of bird. Rarer species are also on the cards including wild dog, cheetah, honey badger, civet, serval, bushpig, porcupine and bushbaby.

Take a smooth and serene boat cruise either at dawn or for sunset on one of our boats. Staying on theme one of our boats is solar powered. There is nothing quite like quietly drifting down the mighty Kafue river taking in the sights and sounds of the river with a breeze in your hair! Spend a relaxing few hours following the river bank to see what is living on the water or coming down to drink. Sunset from the water is particularly beautiful!

Want to be a bit more active?! Head out on a walking safari with one of our specialist walking guides and an armed Zambian Wildlife officer. Using footprints and spoor track game using your own two feet as power. Get up close and personal to nature and appreciate the smaller things that you may miss from a vehicle.

Your best chance to see and photograph predators, large herds of buffalo is on a game drive in an open viewing vehicle. When possible, guests enjoy the use of a private vehicle and dedicated guide. River cruises make for relaxed game viewing, photography and bird watching. You will be entertained by baboons, hippo, elephant, crocodiles, water buck nd the occasional buffalo on the river bank and the Zambezi's various islands.

Sunset cruises make for a spectacular end to a day in the bush. Canoe safaris give a totally different perspective to the African wilderness. Walking safaris are not for the faint-hearted and are best suited during winter months. On a walking safari the focus is mainly on tracks, vegetation, birds and butterflies.






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Days 12 - 13 LIVINGSTONE
